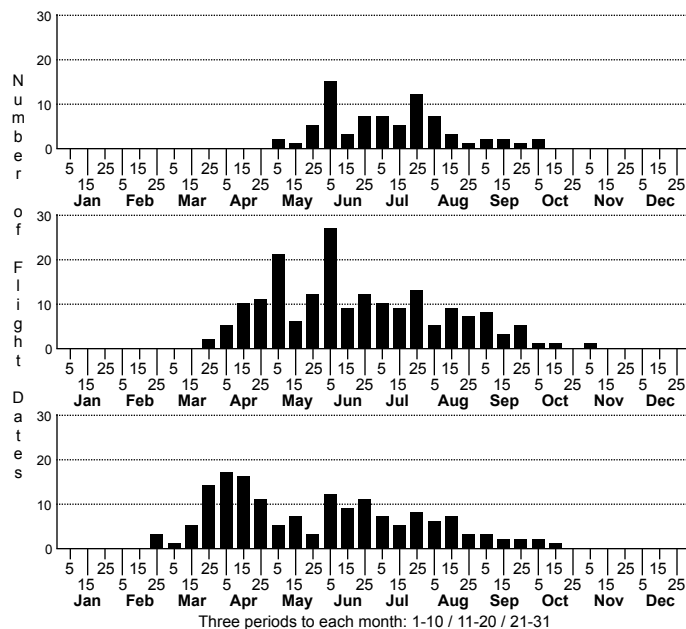


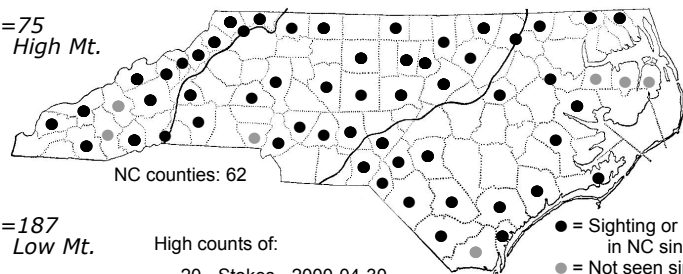
Hypena baltimoralis Baltimore Bomolocha
